Horizon Europe Strategic Plan 2021-2024 Published

The European Commission has adopted the first Strategic Plan for Horizon Europe. The Plan will cover the period of 2021-24 and guide the development of work programmes under Horizon Europe. The approach of having a strategic plan is a new feature for the Framework Programme. It sets out four strategic policy orientations for the period 2021-2024, namely:

- Promoting an open strategic autonomy by leading the development of key digital,
- enabling and emerging technologies, sectors and value chains; • Restoring Europe's ecosystems and biodiversity, and managing sustainably natural
- Making Europe the first digitally enabled circular, climate-neutral and sustainable
- Creating a more resilient, inclusive and democratic European society. Future work programmes will have to be aligned with these orientations.
- The Strategic Plan also includes a number of horizontal areas, such as international cooperation (which is to underpin the four orientations), or, for example, gender, ethics and open science. It also includes the EU Missions, one of the novelties in Horizon Europe and identifies the European co-funded and co-programmed Partnerships. Information on the Horizon Europe clusters, as well as a chapter that describes synergies between the three pillars of Horizon Europe also feature in the new Strategic Plan. For applicants, this can be a useful resource to consult to understand the direction the programme is going in over the coming years, but also to help inform the way project proposals address the impact evaluation criteria.
