

Horizon Europe MSCA Postdoctoral Fellowships (MSCA-PF)

Horizon Europe

[Horizon Europe](#) is a 95 billion euro funding programme for innovation and research, that covers all major scientific and technological disciplines, and encourages collaborative projects (consortium) for a joint goal.

Marie Skłodowska-Curie Actions (MSCA)

[MSCA](#) are a researchers' mobility programme, which are part of Horizon Europe programme, aimed at equipping researchers with new knowledge and skills and providing them with an international as well as inter-sectoral exposure. The MSCA have a bottom-up approach, open to all research domains and applicable for researchers from any nationality and any country.

MSCA Postdoctoral Fellowships (PF)

[MSCA PF](#) are open to excellent researchers of any nationality, including researchers wishing to reintegrate in Europe, as well as researchers with high potential aiming for a career restart in research. The scheme also encourages researchers to work on research and innovation projects in the non-academic sector.

• **Types of fellowships:**

- [European Fellowships](#): 12-24 months recruitment in Europe¹ + 6 optional months in non-academic sector.
- [Global Fellowships](#): 24-36 months (12-24 outgoing phase to a Third Country (TC), outside of Europe & 12 months mandatory return phase in Europe).

• **Eligibility:**

- Require PhD degree at the call deadline.
- Limit research experience: up to 8 years of research experience after PhD at the call deadline, with exceptions:
 - Years outside research and career breaks will not be counted.
 - For nationals & long-term residents of EU Member States (MS) and Associated Countries (AC), who wish to reintegrate from a Third Country (TC) to Europe (i.e. direct mobility to an EU MS or AC within the last 12 months before the call deadline), time of research experience in the TC will not be counted.

- **Secondments:** Can be held worldwide and up to 1/3 of the fellowship duration.

- **Placements at the end of fellowships:** Additional up to 6 months in European organization in non-academic sector.

- **Resubmission restrictions:** Candidates wishing to re-apply after received a score below 70% in the last call, will wait 1 call.
