MSCA Postdoctoral Fellowships (MSCA-PF)

MSCA Postdoctoral Fellowships (PF) are open to excellent PhD researchers of any nationality to work on research and innovation projects internationally, both in the academic and non-academic sector, while receiving living, mobility and training grants for 1-3 years and comprehensive training to develop their skills for their future careers.

- **Types of fellowships:**

- European Fellowships: 12-24 months recruitment in Horizon Europe country + 6 optional months in the non-academic sector.
- Global Fellowships: 24-36 months, out of which 12-24 months are the outgoing phase to a host organization in a country not in Horizon Europe & additional 12 months mandatory return phase to a host organisation in a Horizon Europe country.

- **Eligibility:**

- Requires PhD degree at the call deadline.
- Up to 8 years of full-time equivalent research experience after PhD at the call deadline, with exceptions.

- **Secondments:** Short periods of training and research in additional organisations can be held worldwide.

- **Non-Academic Placements at the end of fellowships:** Optional additional 6 months payment for placement in non-academic organisations located in Horizon Europe countries.

Horizon Europe is a €95 billion funding programme for innovation and research, that covers all major scientific and technological disciplines and encourages collaborative projects (consortium) for a joint goal.

Marie S. Curie Actions (MSCA) are researchers' mobility programmes, which are part of Horizon Europe programme, aimed at equipping researchers with new knowledge and skills and providing them with an international as well as inter-sectoral exposure. The MSCA have a bottom-up approach, open to all research domains and applicable for researchers from any nationality and any country.
