## **TRIACH: TRANSNATIONAL CREATIVE INDUSTRY ACCELERATORS AND HUBS**

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TRIACH (Transnational Creative Industry Accelerators and Hubs) is a project proposal to be submitted to the Horizon Europe programme Call: Horizon Europe – HORIZON-CL2-2026-01-HERITAGE-05. TRIACH seeks to strengthen international collaboration and innovation across Cultural and Creative Industries (CCIs). Bringing together partners from Europe, Asia and Latin America, the project will explore how creative ecosystems can accelerate digital, green and inclusive transitions through stronger links between policy, entrepreneurship and skills development. TRIACH will work with three key stakeholder groups: policymakers and innovation leaders, ambitious creative businesses with growth potential, and creative workers and micro-enterprises at the city/local level. Through international collaboration, knowledge exchange, and real-world testing across diverse territorial contexts, the project aims to develop practical approaches that support cross-border innovation, business growth, capacity building, and sustainable creative ecosystem development. By fostering globally connected networks and promoting mutually beneficial partnerships, TRIACH will contribute to a more resilient, inclusive and innovation-driven creative economy while reinforcing the role of culture and creativity in addressing shared global challenges.
