The Israel manager presented the KORIL funding program & concept of Light House program at the conference.







R&D technology opportunities between two countries and arrange B2B meetings in the fields of robotics, autonomous vehicles and smart factory.


Dr. Choi, the Chair of International Cooperation of KITECH.


